

Liga Lisboa 2011



Games and teams

- There are 45 players and 4 teams registered.
- Cost is €5 per player to be paid to Patrick before the first game. The proceeds go to FPUD
- Format is round robin, semies (1 vs 4, 2 vs 3), and finals
- Playing days are November 3, 10, 17, and December 1 (semies) and 15 (finals)
- Games are **start** at 9 PM and at 10 PM
- Location: Beach in front of Bar Grande Onda, praia de Carcavelos
- In case of bad weather there are catch-up rounds on November 24 and December 8
- The decision if games will be cancelled will be made at 6 PM each Thursday and will be announced on the FFindr page (<http://ffindr.com/en/event/liga-lisboa-2011>) and through the BUG-Lisboa mailing list (<http://sports.groups.yahoo.com/group/bug-lisboa/>)

Rules

- All games are played by the official [WFDF Rules](#) of Ultimate with the inclusion of the [BULA Beach Ultimate Appendix](#).
- After 35 minutes of play the end of regular play time is indicated. Play continues until the next score is made. After this score a 'cap' is set which is 2 points more than the current highest score. The winner of the game is the team that first reaches the 'cap'.
- The only exception is when a team reaches 13 points. When this happens the game is over irrespective of the score or time.
- Captains are responsible for the team on and off the field as well as making sure people are on time and telling team players if a day has been cancelled.
- If a team can not start a game within 5 minutes of the official starting time, without good reason, the opponent will receive one point per minute until the opponent can start play.
- Each team is allowed 1 timeout per game. Each timeout lasts one minute but the time is not added to the overall time (end of the game is still 35 minutes after the start).
- A timeout can be called at any time during the game, including the cap.
- Tie-breakers for round-robin:
 - won-loss records, counting only games between the teams that are tied. When only two teams are involved, this rule is commonly called "head-to-head".
 - point differentials, counting only games between the teams that are tied.
 - point differentials, counting games against all common opponents.
 - points scored, counting only games among the teams that are tied.
 - points scored, counting games against all common opponents.
- Offense determines # of women on the field (min 1) but cannot exceed # women opponent has
